A victim of human trafficking may look like many of the people you see everyday. Can you recognize victims of human trafficking among the people you help everyday?

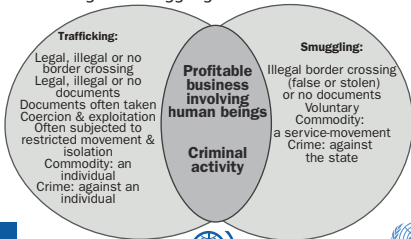
Here are some indications that a person may be trafficked:

- ◇ Does the person show fear, anxiety or a lack of confidence? Does he/she prefer others to speak on his/her behalf?
- ◇ Does the person show signs that his/her movements are being controlled?
- ◇ Does the person show signs of injuries that appear to be the result of the application of control measures?
- ◇ Is the person travelling accompanied by suspicious individuals or travelling in groups with persons who are not relatives or do not speak the same language?
- ◇ If a minor, is she/he travelling unaccompanied?
- ◇ If a minor, does she/he look intimidated or behave in a way that is unusual for a child?
